

Outdoor Discoveries 2025!

Looking for a fun, outdoor program for your children for this summer?

Salt Pond Areas Bird Sanctuaries, Inc. and Kerri Moynihan & Mari Pandiscio (Session 5 only) are partnering to offer hands-on activities, crafts, and games centered on the natural environment for children 4-8 years old. Each program will take place at Bourne Farm, from **9am – 1pm**, the perfect setting for discovering the outdoors! Participants will go on woodland hikes, explore the fields, create craft projects to take home, fish from Crocker Pond and play games while enjoying being outside!

All sessions include a **weekly topic** exploration through literature, arts & crafts and exploring all Bourne Farm has to offer! Fishing poles and bait will be provided.



Session 1: July 8, 9, & 10th, Tues. - Thurs. Farm Week!- Bourne Farm has so much to offer! We will make fairy houses and gnome homes from natural materials, visit Grasshopper Hill, the cow tunnel, and plant in the Children's Bee Garden!



Session 2: July 15, 16, & 17th, Tues. - Thurs.- Marine Week!- We will learn about marine vessels and design our own boats from recycled materials!



Session 3: July 22, 23, 24th, Tues. - Thurs.- Beauty in Nature!- There is so much nature-filled beauty at Bourne Farm! Observing nature in the pine grove, painting by the wildflower gardens, and printing nature into clay are just some examples of nature-related projects we will do this week!



Session 4: July 29, 30, & 31st, Tues.- Thurs. – Hunters Above in our Cape Cod Skies! What do our local birds of prey hunt? How do they hunt? Where do they live? Along with learning about these amazing creatures, we'll also discover smaller birds living on Bourne Farm. Children will make bird feeders to take home this week!



Session 5: Aug.12, 13 & 14, Tues. – Thurs. – Art in Nature – Come explore the cycle of life and the awe inspiring colors found in nature. Through hands on activities and guided outdoor excursions, children will study the transformations of insects and animals, such as caterpillars evolving into butterflies or tadpoles becoming frogs, and use these metamorphic cycles for inspiration for their own creative art projects.
