Program Staff

The Outdoor Discoveries program staff for sessions 1-4 is Kerri Moynihan and for the Art in Nature program in Aug. it is Mari Pandiscio, who both enjoy and are very experienced in working with children in this age group, as a public school teacher in Mashpee, MA and a substitute art teacher in the Falmouth Public Elementary schools. All staff members are coried and dedicated to making your child's experience safe, enriching and enjoyable. Kerri and Mari have junior helper as well to assist with the activities. Kerri and Mari are available to address your questions or concerns at any time during the program.

Drop-Off/Pick-Up Information

Drop off is at 9:00am at Bourne Farm, we will meet outdoors under the grape arbor by the farmhouse. Program staff will greet participants there every morning at drop-off and release children to responsible adults at 1pm at the same location. All pick-ups must be made by an adult on the Emergency Contact/Release List, and photo ID may be required. For safety reasons, please always park in the parking lot area and use caution when driving on the driveway, as children will be crossing this area. Please stress this to designated drop-off and pick-up persons also.

Things to Bring

- **A snack, drink & lunch** – We will have a morning snack each day and a lunch break. Please provide one for your child. Please **do not** pack any food containing peanuts, peanut butter or any nut products. Please provide plenty of water and/or drinks.

- This is an outdoor program, please **apply sun block and bug repellent** as you see fit before each class. On hot days, we will have the sprinkler out for running through. Please have your child bring a towel and wear a bathing suit under their clothes, so they can enjoy the sprinkler time (*the instructors will not be able to change children into or out of bathing suits*). This will be an end of day activity, if time allows. Please check your child after class for ticks and have them wear appropriate shoes/sneakers for walking around on the farm (*no flip flops or sandals*). We will have a rain date on the Friday of the week of the program, if we need to cancel due to severe storms. We will hold the program if it is just raining because we can go inside the barn. If we end early due to storms but can hold most of the session, make up hours will not take place.
